

Compounded Medications

Compounded medications are medications that are specifically formulated for your pets individual needs. These tend to be used where there are no commercially available medications that would suit your pets needs. Here at Racecourse Road Veterinary Clinic, we try to make the process of sourcing compounded medications as simple as possible.

If your pet requires a compounded medication, your veterinarian will write a script, which will be sent directly to our compounding pharmacy. The pharmacy will then call you, to confirm your details for express delivery of the medications, and to organise payment. Your pet's medication will then be delivered straight to your doorstep!

In most cases, your veterinarian will authorise repeats on the script. Therefore, when needed, you can contact the pharmacy for a repeat delivery. You will be advised by the pharmacy when your script has expired, at which time your pet will be due for a progress examination in the clinic.

For ongoing medications, your pet will need to have an examination in clinic every 6 months, be up to date with vaccinations, and depending on the medication regular blood testing may be required.
